# **Campus Spotlight**

#### **FARROW MANOR CAMPUS MEETS SPECIFIC NEED**

In an effort to protect BCV children and staff, The Baptist Children's Village leadership made the difficult decision in March to temporarily suspend new admissions. Since then BCV staff have longed to open their hearts to new children. Today we know much more about coronavirus and have had time to develop a plan that allows us to both protect current BCV children and staff and safely admit new children in need of our services.

Staff at our Farrow Manor Campus in Independence has agreed to serve as a quarantine campus and have helped develop protocols that allow for safe integration into the larger BCV population. These protocols include a two-week quarantine for all new residents on the Farrow Manor Campus before they are transferred to their campus. During that quarantine time, staff will help children with

distance learning in the appropriate school district so they can keep up with their schoolwork.

While the BCV Admissions Committee has incorporated new safety guidelines into their admissions process, the sacrifice and diligence of staff on our Farrow Manor Campus means we can reach out to children and families in our state more quickly, and do so safely for all involved.

The Farrow Manor Campus is named for Miss Ada Farrow, affectionately known as Miss Ada, who was the original donor of this rural campus. Farrow Manor was added to The Baptist Children's Village ministry in 1975. Since we admitted the first child to that campus in September of that year, God has used the staff and the surrounding community to reach hundreds of children and families with the gospel. Today they continue to be a vital part of the ministry.



# Iron Sharpens Iron

For years The Baptist Children's Village has enjoyed a collaborative relationship with sister agencies throughout our state and country. Strong leadership has been strengthened all the more with the sharing of ideas and information. Today BCV policies, programs and staff continue to benefit from relationships with coalitions and like-minded agencies. Executive Director Sean Milner currently serves as Vice President on two organizational boards, and on the legislative committee for another organization that advocates for excellence in residential childcare.

The Baptist Coalition for Children and Families (BCCF) is a network of Christian organizations. According to their website their purpose is to "strengthen its members and their respective organizations through leadership development, dynamic relationships, education and advocacy."

The stated purpose of the second such board on which Milner serves is, "to speak with a unified voice to enhance the quality of life of Mississippi's children in out-of-home care and their families through services of advocacy, education and empowerment. Mississippi Association of Child Care Agencies, Inc. (MACCA) is made up of non-profit residential childcare agencies in Mississippi.

The Baptist Children's Village serves children and families throughout Mississippi, but the lives of those clients are enhanced through our relationship with national organizations like CORE (Coalition of Residential Excellence). We share their belief that "Two are better than one because they have a good return for their

labor." This Ecclesiastes truth reinforces the value of collaboration among believers and ministries with shared responsibilities to rescue hurting children.

Involvement in these statewide and national organizations allows for iron to sharpen iron and promotes excellence in residential childcare.

Another significant value in these relationships is our ability to collectively represent a unified voice in advocating for the needs of children and families from hard places on things like legislative issues that carry the potential to impact residential childcare. HR Bill 8443 -Cottage Homes Investing in the lives of Dependent Children (CHILD) Act, recently introduced by Florida Representatives Neal Dunn, M.D. and Alcee L. Hastings, would legislatively establish the cottage home model as a resource for at-risk children and families throughout the nation. A strong coordinated effort to pass this bill will be required, so The Baptist Children's Village is grateful to be in the fight with such an army of collaborators.

In 2019 Milner worked with the Mississippi Center for Public Policy, MACCA, legislators and other advocates to pass the Children's Promise Act (HB 1613). The Children's Promise Act gave donors the ability to give to The BCV a part of the monies they would have normally had to pay to the state in income taxes. This was a win-win for both the agencies like The Baptist Children's Village and donors. We are looking forward to more legislative victories like this one.

# Staff Spotlight

Bill and Peggy Tate will soon celebrate 25 years in ministry at The Baptist Children's Village. Bill had previously served as pastor in Mississippi and Peggy has always served alongside him with children's ministries. Their lives together have consistently been about service to others. Bill and Peggy both grew up in New Albany, Mississippi, met at Northside Baptist Church and married in December of 1978. Bill was ordained to the ministry in 1985 in Ingram Baptist Church in Baldwyn. He completed several Bible classes through Blue Mountain College to help prepare him for the pastorate. The couple has served together in north Mississippi most of their lives, including as houseparents, maintenance director and secretary on two BCV campuses.

Today Bill is the Campus Director at the Farrow Manor Campus in Independence; and the Reedy Acres Campus in Water Valley. Peggy continues to serve alongside her husband as secretary for the Farrow Manor Campus. As I talked with them over lunch recently, the memories came flooding back as they recalled story after story of children whom they have influenced over the last 25 years. One such memory was of their early days as houseparents of young children. Before bedtime each evening, they shared Bible stories with those in their

care. They would then pray with each one individually—Bill with the boys and Peggy with the girls. Both recall what a sweet time this was in their ministry. They were able to witness first-hand the power of prayer for the children.

The term, "Jack of all trades," comes to mind when reflecting on how God prepared Bill for his ministry at the BCV. He has worked as a pastor, a welder, a police officer, an EMT, and a sheet metal fabricator. His father taught him electrical and plumbing skills. He later received his Associate degree in HVAC from Northwest Community College.

Though you might look at Bill's resume and consider him to be highly skilled, he was hesitant to accept the offer to fill the Campus Director position, feeling inadequate for the task. He vividly recalls the combination of God's direction, staff encouragement, and insistence from his mother, that eventually led him to accept the task. The days have often been long and the job a challenging one filled with overwhelming joys and excruciating heartache; but God's plan is a perfect one; and His grace and provision is sufficient for the journey. They continue even today to seek how the Lord will use them in His service.



# Mississippi Businesses Eligible for Tax Credit

Your Tax Liability . . . Give it to the Government . . . or Give it to Change Children's Lives.



#### Businesses can help children without affecting their budgets.

There exists a new opportunity for Mississippi business owners to help provide homes, food, education, and medical care for at-risk children in Mississippi. They are able to do this without changing or increasing their budgeted charitable donations or expenses.

#### Here is how.

Passed in 2019 by the MS Legislature, the Children's Promise Act (MS code §27-7-22.39 & §27-7-22.41) allows business owners to receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit of up to half their 2021 MS tax liability by gifting that portion to an Eligible Charitable Organization (ECO) like The Baptist Children's Village.
